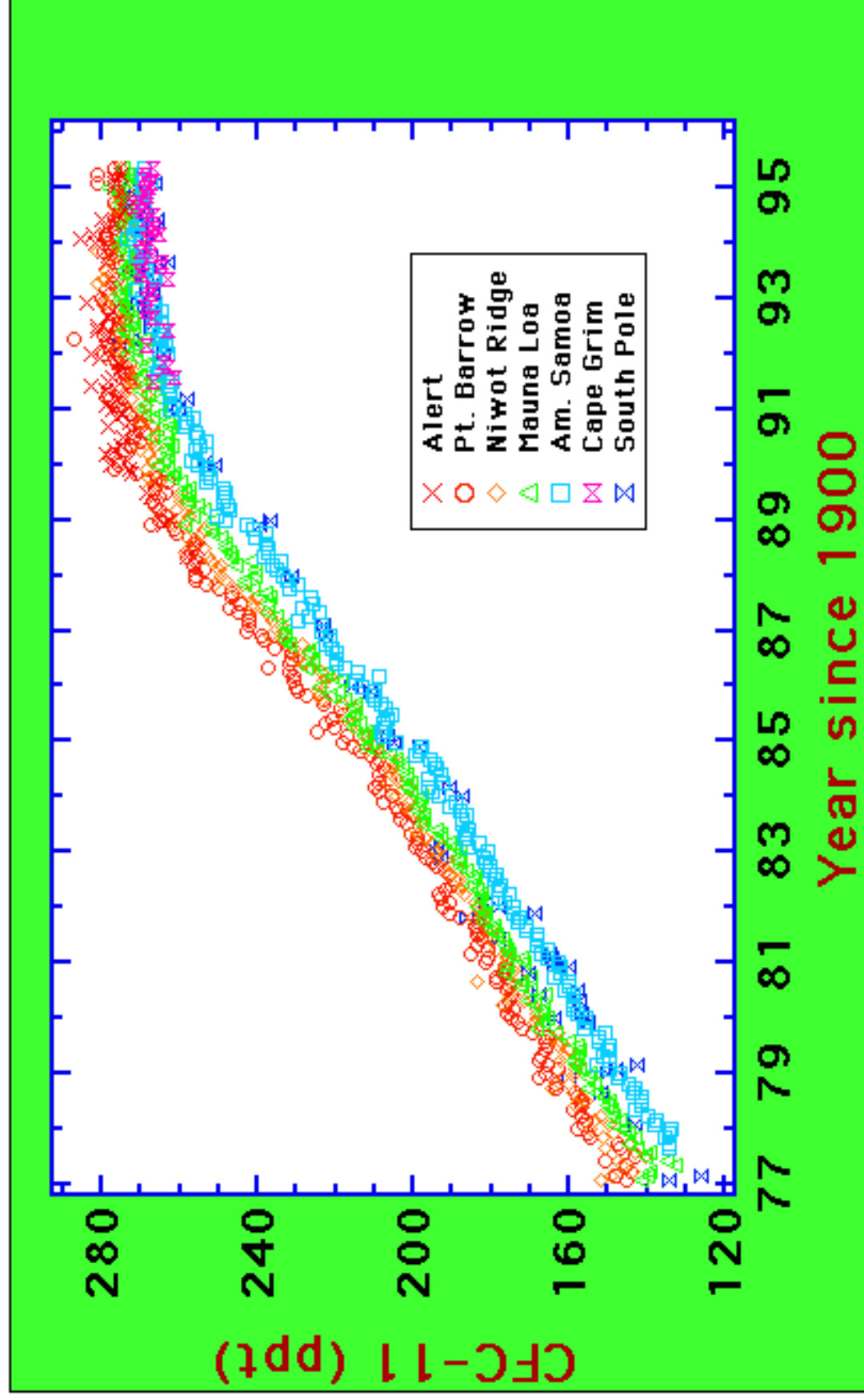




# NOAA/CMDL CFC-11 Flask Monthly Means



Monthly means reported as dry mixing ratios in parts per trillion (ppt) for chlorofluorocarbon-11 (CFC-11) at ground level for four NOAA/CMDL stations (Pt. Barrow, Alaska; Mauna Loa, Hawaii; Cape Matatula, American Samoa; and South Pole) and three cooperative stations (Alert, NWT, Canada {Atmospheric Environment Service}; Niwot Ridge, Colorado {University of Colorado}; Cape Grim Baseline Air Pollution Station, Tasmania, Australia, {Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organization}).
