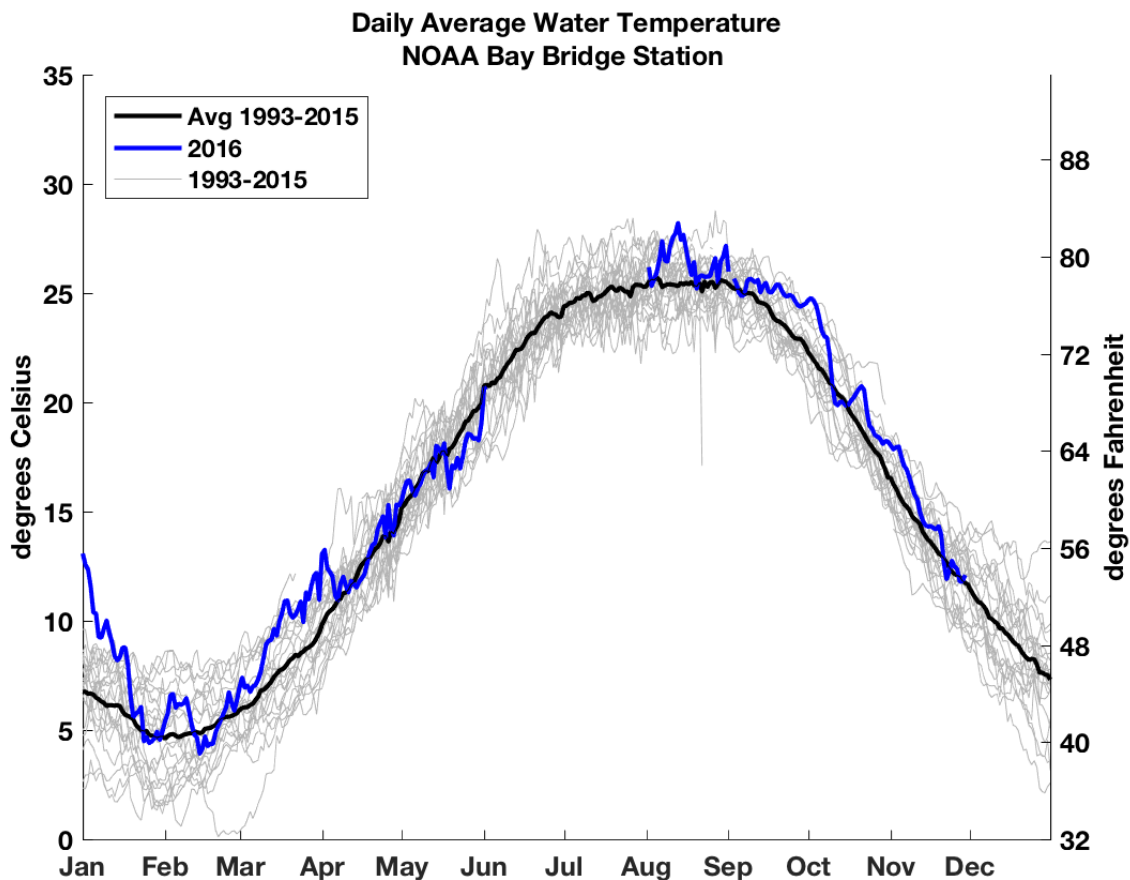
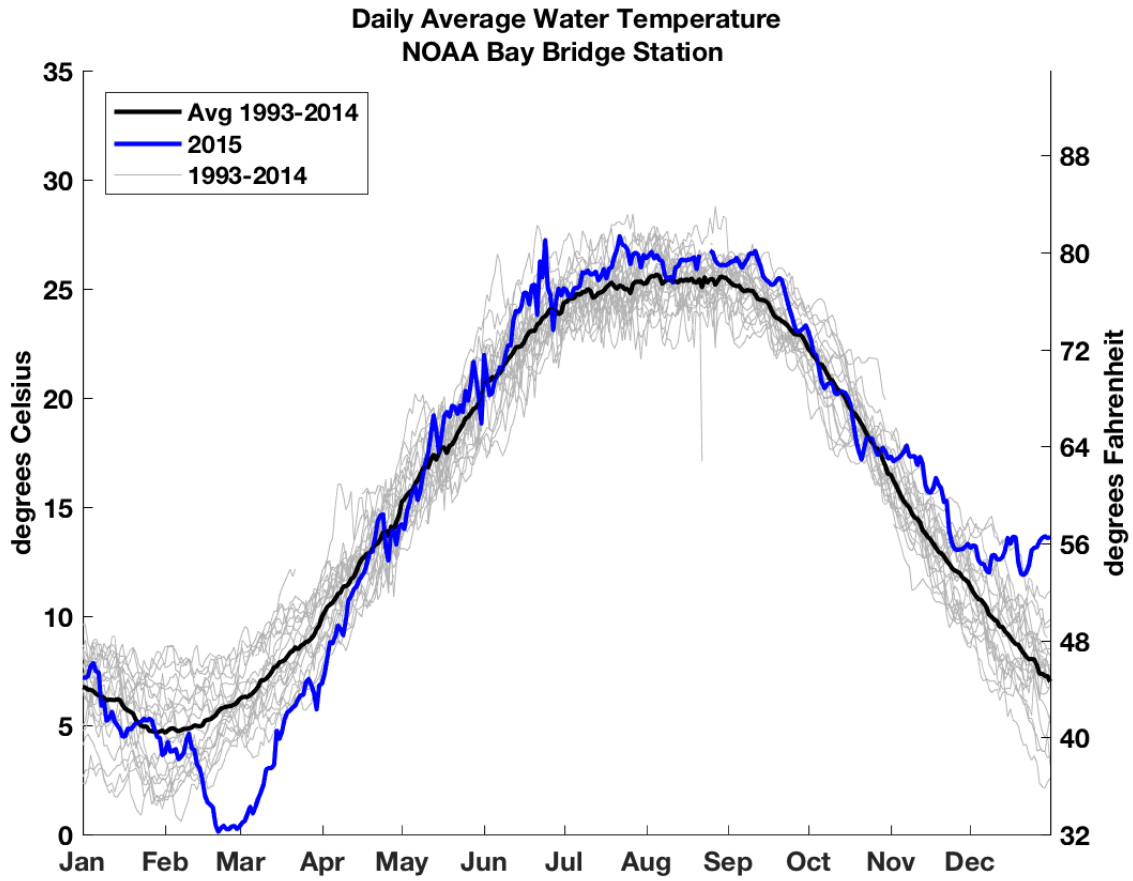


Historical record of water temperatures in Chesapeake Bay

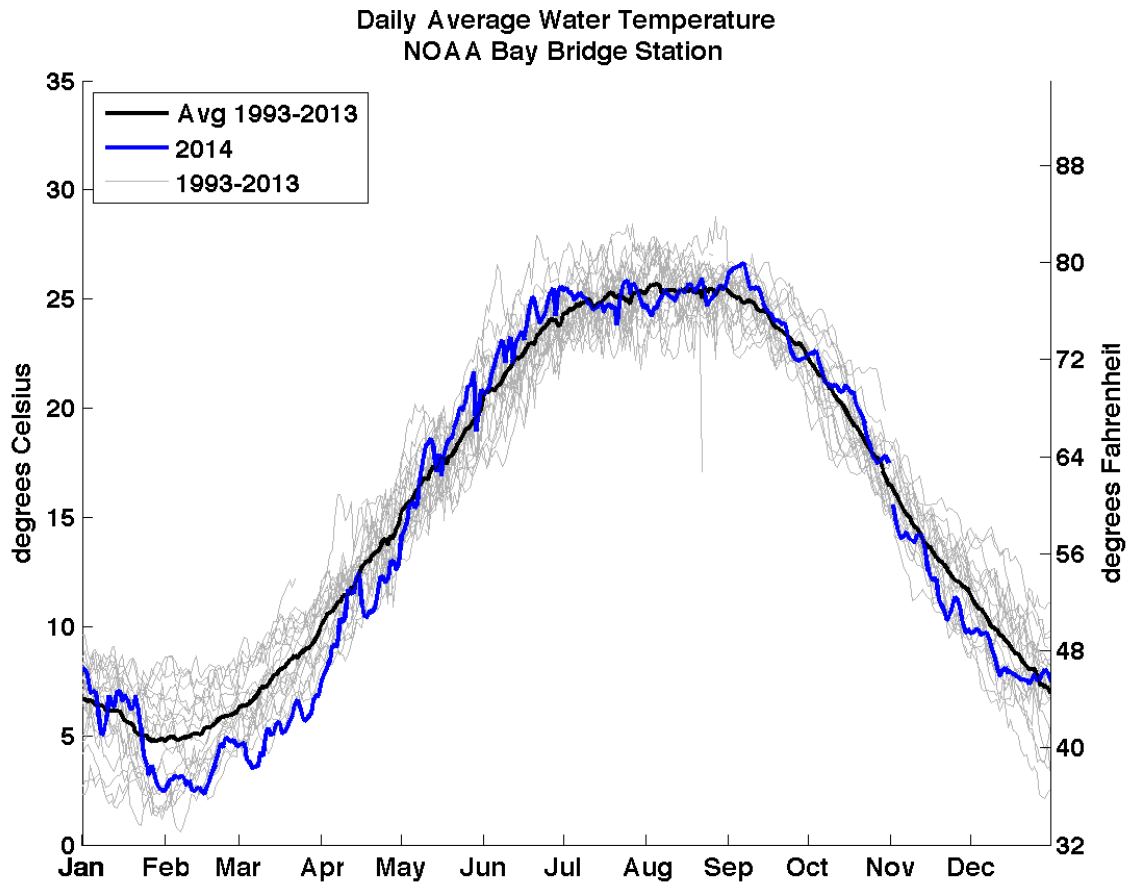
The following plots show water temperatures measured at the Chesapeake Bay Bridge Tunnel station. The BLUE line shows water temperature data for a specific year. The heavy BLACK line is the average of all water temperatures for each day over a range of years and the GRAY lines represent the entire dataset for that same range with a line for each year.



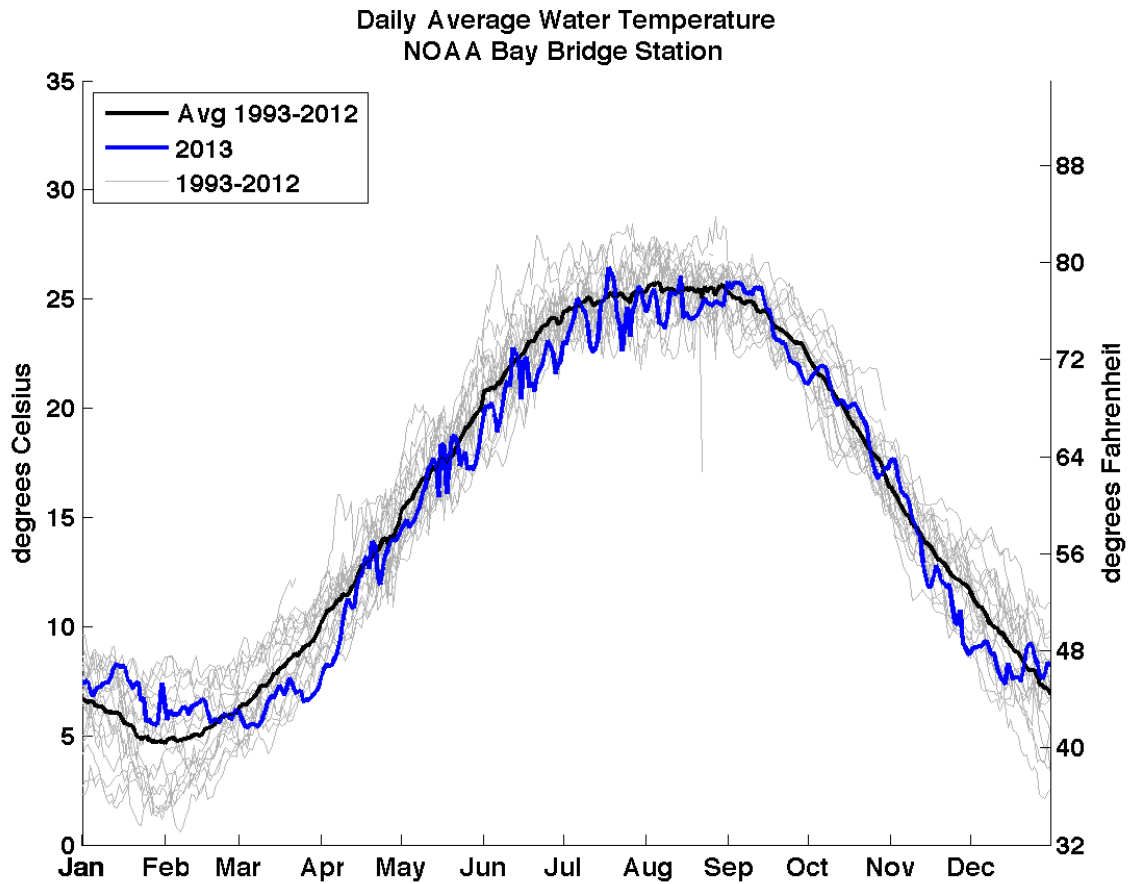
Temperatures in December 2015 and January 2016 were much warmer than in previous years!



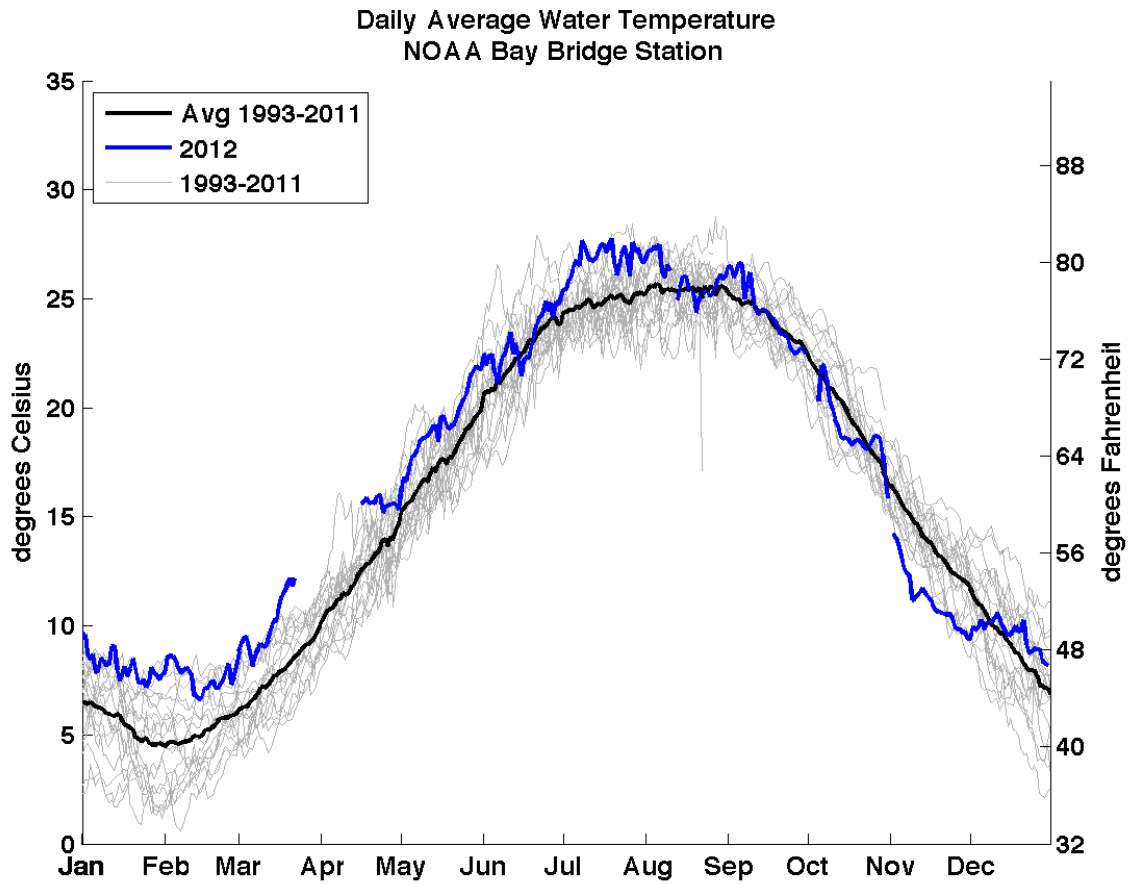
Temperatures from mid-February to mid-March in 2015 were much cooler than in any previous years!



Temperatures from February to March 2014 were quite cool compared to other years.



Overall, 2013 temperatures were a bit cooler than the average. In January and February, temperatures were warmer.



In the first half of 2012, temperatures were warmer than average.
